Help Build Our New Organ! As you know, our current organ is on it's "last note" and the Organ Search Group is working away this summer in search of the perfect organ that will best serve our congregation. They are currently researching the various instruments at Allen Organ Co. As a supplemental way of raising money for this organ, we are running the "KEYS FOR GOD'S KINGDOM" campaign between May 2010 and March 2011. For an affordable donation of \$50 you can add a key, foot pedal or stop to the organ. During this time, we hope to raise \$12,000+ to add to our existing Organ Fund balance of \$16,000 towards our anticipated total of \$40,000. Watch the campaign progress on the Narthex kiosk poster as we fill in donated keys and build our new chancel organ. Our goal is to have the new organ installed in time for an Easter 2011 dedication. We will have updated information on the kiosk along with a flyer with donation information and donation envelopes for your convenience.

Five dollars – Free for the taking! Have you noticed the play money showing up here and there in our church? There seems to be five dollars everywhere. In truth, every Sunday the Fellowship Hall is loaded with "free" five-dollar bills waiting to be picked up and dropped in the offering plate. Five percent is the average discount we've been earning on the sale of gift cards. For every one hundred dollars worth of scrip sold, the church realizes a profit of

five dollars. If every family bought just one hundred dollars worth of grocery, gasoline, department store, home improvement, pharmacy, or restaurant cards each week, we'd have over \$1,000 a week to pay down our debt. Does your family budget include \$400 or \$500 a month for those necessities? Please spend that money using gift cards and help us pay down *our* debt.

\$.00 contribution = \$10,000 debt reduction. How can that be? That is exactly what the Scrip program has done for Christ the King so far. No one who has purchased gift cards has increased his or her contributions to the mortgage fund and yet we have raised about \$10,000 to apply to the principle of our mortgage. And at this point, only about fifty families have participated. Is your family one of the fifty? Think how much more we can reduce the debt if everyone participated. For every dollar you spend on the program, you receive one dollar of purchasing power at your favorite retail outlets... and our church receives about five percent of what you spend... compliments of the merchants. Spread the word! This is a "No-brainer" when it comes to fund-raising. Gift cards are available every Sunday in the Fellowship Hall.
