**Help Build Our New Organ!** As you know, our current organ is on it's "last note" and the Organ Search Group is working away this summer in search of the perfect organ that will best serve our congregation. They are currently researching the various instruments at Allen Organ Co. As a supplemental way of

raising money for this organ, we are running the "KEYS FOR GOD'S KINGDOM" campaign between May 2010 and March 2011. For an affordable donation of \$50 you can add a key, foot pedal or stop to the organ. During this time, we hope to raise \$12,000+ to add to our existing Organ Fund balance of \$17,000 towards our anticipated total of \$40,000. Watch the campaign progress on the Narthex kiosk poster as we fill in donated keys and build our new chancel organ. Our goal is to have the new organ installed in time for an Easter 2011 dedication. We will have updated information on the kiosk along with a flyer with donation information and donation envelopes for your convenience.

**Relay For Life:** Christ the King has supported RFL at the Cumming fairgrounds for many years. This year we did not participate. The event is declining in organizations and attendance. Local restaurants are selling food which makes our own efforts to raise money at the event more difficult. Alternate ideas for raising funds at the event have not worked. In 2009 our booth barely broke even. We did support RFL in 2010 with our own fund-raisers such as the Irish Dinner and Auction and sent a check for over \$4000 to the American Cancer Society. We would like your opinion on whether we should continue to support RFL and/or what ministries we should support with our fundraising. Currently our 2 largest fund-raisers support RFL and Habitat For Humanity (Yard Sale). In the near future Outreach will prepare a survey to check-in with the congregation asking for your opinions on continuing to support these ministries versus others that you may prefer.
